The Buffalo, New York facility of Materion Advanced Materials Group has been deemed a Conflict-Free Gold Refiner and is in compliance with the Conflict-Free Smelter protocol since February 2013.

The Conflict-Free Smelter program is a voluntary global initiative developed by the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC) and the Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSI) to provide a credible system for companies to substantiate responsible sourcing. Upon successful review by the Audit Review Committee (ARC), Materion was added to the CFS Compliant Smelter and Refiners List. The Materion's Buffalo facility is now qualified by the ARC as a compliant Gold Refiner.

Materion has a long history of social and environmental responsibility. Due to our standard precious and valuable metal reclaim and recycling practices, most of the gold used in the manufacturing of our sputtering targets, evaporation materials and other products is provided by our own in-house reclaim and recycled facilities. As expected, we verify all exterior material sources as conflict-free, under the requirements of the Conflict-Free Sourcing Initiative (CFSI).
